



Plugin Not Showing in My DAW

If you installed the plugin but can't find it in your DAW:

- Restart your DAW after installation
- Run a plugin rescan in your DAW's plugin manager
- Make sure your DAW supports VST3 (Windows/macOS) or AU (macOS)
- Check that the plugin was installed in the default system plugin folders

Typical plugin locations:

macOS

- VST3 → /Library/Audio/Plug-Ins/VST3
- AU → /Library/Audio/Plug-Ins/Components

Windows

- VST3 → C:\Program Files\Common Files\VST3

Look for plugins listed under: **Little Cubes**

No Sound / No Input Signal

If the plugin loads but you hear no sound:

- Make sure your audio interface is selected in your DAW audio settings
- Check that your guitar input is assigned to the track
- Enable input monitoring on the track
- Make sure the track is record/monitor-enabled

If the input meter in your DAW moves, the plugin is receiving signal.

Latency or Crackling Audio

This is usually related to your audio buffer settings.

- Increasing your buffer size
 - Closing other CPU-heavy applications
 - Using your audio interface driver instead of system audio

Installation Issues

Installation Tips

- Always run the installer package included in your download
- Do not manually copy plugin files
- Restart your DAW after installation

If you're reinstalling:

- Uninstall the plugin first / delete all files related to the plugins
 - Run the installer again

Download Installers

If you need to download the installers again, log into your Little Cubes account using the email address you used when purchasing the plugins.
